STUDENT DRESS-CODE

BASIC EXPECTATION

TO KEEP SCHOOL A WELCOMING SPACE FOR EVERYONE, CLOTHING MUST:

-  Cover undergarments, bottom, belly, and other private areas at all times, even when bending, stretching, or sitting
-  Not include profanity, hate speech, sexually explicit content, or references to drugs, nicotine, alcohol, or weapons.
-  Not present a safety concern such as excessively long chains, spiked accessories, or clothing that drags on the ground.
-  Allow full participation in school activities and not disrupt the school day.

WHAT'S ALLOWED

STUDENTS MAY WEAR:

-  Tops that cover the chest, belly, bottom, and private areas; undergarments must stay covered too.
-  Bottoms (jeans, shorts, skirts, joggers, leggings, and sweatpants) that fit comfortably and provide proper coverage.
-  Athletic wear, such as track pants, yoga pants, and jerseys, that is not see-through or revealing.
-  Footwear of choice, including sneakers, sandals, or boots. Closed-toe shoes may be required for certain classes, clubs, sports, or activities (PE, labs, field trips, etc.).

DRESS CODE

As we prepare for the 2026–2027 school year, we want to ensure our schools remain safe, welcoming, and focused on learning!

Students may wear T-shirts and tops that provide appropriate coverage, jeans, joggers, shorts, skirts, leggings, sweatpants, and athletic wear that is not see-through or revealing. Students may also wear footwear of their choice; however, closed-toe shoes may be required for certain classes, clubs, sports, labs, or field trips.

Clothing should not reveal private areas or undergarments; include profanity, hate speech, sexually explicit content, or references to drugs, nicotine, alcohol, or weapons; create a safety concern; or disrupt the school day.

If a dress code concern arises, our goal is to address it privately, respectfully, and with kindness—never to embarrass a student, but to support them and keep the focus on learning.

CELL PHONE LEGISLATION (Florida House Bill 379)
